ARTICLE III. **Officers**

Section 1: Titles of Officers

2. Christina Rizos - Treasurer
3. Riana Go - President

Section 2: Selection of Officers

Officers will be selected by the members. They will be voted on and each member is eligible to run for office.

Section 3: Duties

1. President: oversees club duties.
2. VP: notifies club members of future projects.
3. Secretary: takes notes during all club meetings
4. Treasurer: oversees money & finances.
5. StuCo Rep(s): attends student council meetings and notifies student council on past and future projects.
6. Historian: documents club activities.

ARTICLE IV. **Club Members**

Section 1: Requirements

Section 2: Duties
