

**The Constitution of the Ridgewood High School activity/club formally known as
THE REBELLION**

Article I

The Rebellion

Article II

The purpose of The Rebellion is to offer students a creative outlet through the form of a school newspaper and website. The Rebellion strives for the inclusion of all students, and offers them the ability to pursue a variety of journalistic passions.

Article III

Section 1: Titles/Duties of Officers

- A. Editor-in-Chief: Collect and edit all the submitted articles, set deadlines, work with the formatting editor to edit the newspaper, and oversee the final product of the newspaper. Also, act as the Treasurer of the Rebellion.
- B. Co-Editor: Second-in-command to the editor-in-chief; edit all the submitted articles first and then send them to the editor-in-chief for proofreading.
- C. Website Editor: Oversee the design and content placed on the club's website, and edit articles that are published on there.
- D. Formatting Editor: Use editing software to create the physical newspaper, confer with the editor-in-chief, and design/choose the graphics for the newspaper.
- E. Editorial Advisor: Assist/advise the editor-in-chief, and also proofread the submitted articles for the newspaper and the website.
- F. Maintain at least Passing or Proficient status in all classes.

Article IV

Section 1: Requirements to become a member

- A. Simply display a passion for creativity and/or journalism.

Section 2: Duties

- A. Submit articles/drawings/other creative media for our seasonal newspapers or for our website.

Section 3: Club Responsibilities

- A. Attend all scheduled meetings or communicate to one of the officers or advisor if you cannot attend.
- B. Join the club's GroupMe for updates on meetings and deadlines.
- C. Submit at least one article/project per every newspaper cycle, which will either be published in the school newspaper or on The Rebellion's website.
- D. Turn in all articles on time.
- E. Maintain at least Passing or Proficient status in all classes.

Article V

Section 1: When, where, time, and how often

- A. Short meetings with officers will take place roughly once a week, and full club meetings will take place monthly. Times (mostly Thursday Rebel Period) and locations (room 203 or 241) OR will be determined on the "GroupMe" a few days prior to the meeting.

Section 2: Structure of Meetings

- A. During weekly meetings members will give officers a quick update on what they are working on.
- B. During full club/monthly meetings members will discuss big-picture goals with the officers and the advisor.

Article VI

Section 1: Reason constituting impeachment procedures

A. The consistent failure of an officer to communicate with other members, complete their assigned tasks, or attend meetings will result in impeachment. Three or more instances of this constitute impeachment.

Section 2: Impeachment process

- A. Any member can bring an issue with an officer to the advisor.
- B. The advisor will then convene with the officers that are not the subject of the impeachment and vote on whether or not they should impeach the officer. They may also decide to give a warning or put an officer on probation.
- C. If the advisor and the remaining officers decide to impeach an officer, the advisor will notify the officer that they have been impeached.

Article VII

Section 1: Reasons constituting expulsion procedures

- A. Failure to attend more than three consecutive meetings without notification can result in the expulsion of a member. Also, failure to meet two or more deadlines that one has previously agreed upon can result in expulsion.
- B. Plagiarism of a work is taken very seriously and will also result in expulsion.

Section 2: Expulsion procedures

A. The officer and the advisor will convene to discuss the performance of the member. Before impeachment, the officers may also issue a warning to the member or put him or her on probation. If these two attempts have already been exhausted, the officers and advisor will vote on whether or not to expulse the member.

Section 3: Expulsion notification

A. Once the expulsion has been voted on, the advisor will notify the member of the decision.
